

Trail Name	Job's Peak Ranch Trail
Trail uses	Hiking (pedestrian use only)
Trail Length	1.5 miles
Difficulty	Family Friendly, light to moderate
Description and Restrictions	The trail begins at the trailhead located on Foothill Road and follows an easement through Job's Peak Ranch, a gated residential development. The first portion is through a sage-covered open-space area. After a gradual uphill, the trail enters a forested area, crosses a small creek, and continues through the forest with beautiful valley views, crosses a riparian area followed by a climb where it currently ends at a paved road and the NV/CA state line. Eventually this trail will be extended to the USFS boundary when the developer provides the trail easement through the California portion of the residential development. It is crucial that hikers do not go beyond this point, enter this gated community via the paved road, or venture onto other private property at the end of the current trail. The trail easement is only 15 feet wide and keeping the landowners happy will go a long way to obtaining other easements to access public lands.
Detailed Directions from I 80 or 395 to parking.	Driving south on US395 into Minden, NV, take Highway 88 to Mottsville, turn right and drive to Foothill Rd (State Route 206), turn left and drive 2.5 miles to trailhead. Driving north on US395 toward Gardnerville, NV, turn left on Dresslerville (Route 756), follow to Centerville Rd, continue across Highway 88 to Foothill Rd, turn left and drive ~1 miles to trailhead.
