PAST, PRESENT & FUTURE PROJECTS

- Secured a \$396,378 Question 1 Grant from the Nevada Division of State Lands in 2008 to plan and construct the 22-mile Genoa Foothill Trail System. Environmental studies by the U.S. Forest Service are in progress, with trail construction anticipated to begin in 2011.
- Completed the Fay-Luther/Jobs Peak Ranch trails link in 2008.
- Secured grants for signage and benches for the Fay-Luther Trail in 2008. Directional signs, maps and benches were installed in 2009. New interpretive signs will be installed in 2010.
- Partnered with the Nature Conservancy to build the Bently-Kirman Ranch Trail along the Carson River, opening in 2010.
- Partnering with Clear Creek Tahoe to plan access to public land in the Clear Creek watershed.
- Received a technical assistance grant from the National Park Service's Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance program in 2009. The grant provides a planner from the NPS who will guide CVTA's effort to access and construct a connected Carson Valley Trail.
- Expanded the annual Hike for Health fundraiser to include an auction and a Trails Challenge.
